CHILD ABUSE NETWORK HELPS INNOCENT VICTIMS

The Child Abuse Network (CAN) exists to reduce the trauma that a child abuse investigation can pose for the child. Before our program came into being, children endured stressful examinations and numerous interviews in child welfare offices, police departments and medical clinics. At each visit, the child was asked to retell his/her experience. The process not only duplicated investigative efforts, it also made children repeatedly relive their experience.

Today, CAN delivers a highly effective alternative by bringing multiple agencies together in a safe and comforting environment. CAN enables medical, mental health, investigative and legal professionals to work together under one roof, to provide non-traumatic investigation and to determine whether abuse has occurred.

For an abused child, adjusting to life after abuse is difficult. CAN helps begin the healing.

CAN'S SERVICES ARE VARIED AND CRITICALLY NEEDED

In fiscal year 2011, CAN provided 3,233 services to 1,947 new children. These services were provided within 24-48 hours of the referral of an abuse allegation—all under one roof and at no charge to the families. Services provided include forensic interviews, medical evaluations, mental health consults and referrals, case management/review and Court School. These services aid in the investigation of the alleged abuse and more importantly, help children and families access appropriate community services so that they may begin the healing process.
